1 in 5 Marylanders suffer from mental health and substance use disorders



Behavioral health-related emergency department (ED) visits continue to rise even as all other visits fall



Length of stay for behavioral health patients increased by **3%** from 2017 to 2018

Behavioral health inpatients stayed on average 13 days more than needed due to barriers getting





1/3 of patients arrive in the ED by law enforcement

42% of behavioral health patients in an ED were delayed reaching the next level of care: many needed no hospital care at all
